Stamp to Serve as Co-Vice Chair of National Telecommunications Committee

Iowa Utilities Board (IUB) Member Curt Stamp has been named Co-Vice Chair of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) Committee on Telecommunications.

NARUC President Jim Kerr of North Carolina appointed Stamp to this national leadership position, effective July 1, 2007.

"I am honored that NARUC leadership has given me the opportunity to serve the organization as Co-Vice Chair of the Telecommunications Committee," said Stamp. "I look forward to working with Chairman Tony Clark (North Dakota) and Co-Vice Chair Maureen Harris (New York). With more than 150 local telecommunications carriers, Iowa has unique needs, and this appointment will allow me to bring Iowa's concerns to the national debate."

Stamp has served on the NARUC Committee on Telecommunications since rejoining the IUB as a Board member in September 2005; he was previously a legislative liaison for the IUB between 1995 and 1997. Stamp is also a member of the Intercarrier Compensation Task Force, the Federal-State Joint Board on Separations, and the North American Numbering Council.

Stamp's background includes extensive experience in the telecommunications industry, having served as a legal intern in the Office of the Commissioner of the Federal Communications Commission, as the manager of policy and law for Qwest Corporation, and as an attorney working with telecommunications clients.

Stamp is a member of the Federal Communications Bar Association, Iowa State Bar Association, and the Polk County Bar Association. He received his bachelor's degree in political science and a master's degree in business administration from Iowa State University. Stamp earned his J.D. degree at Drake University Law School.
